...in which the rapid speed of change and the complexity is tremendous. In order to successfully cope, **companies need to understand their current business environment, and visualise its future developments.**

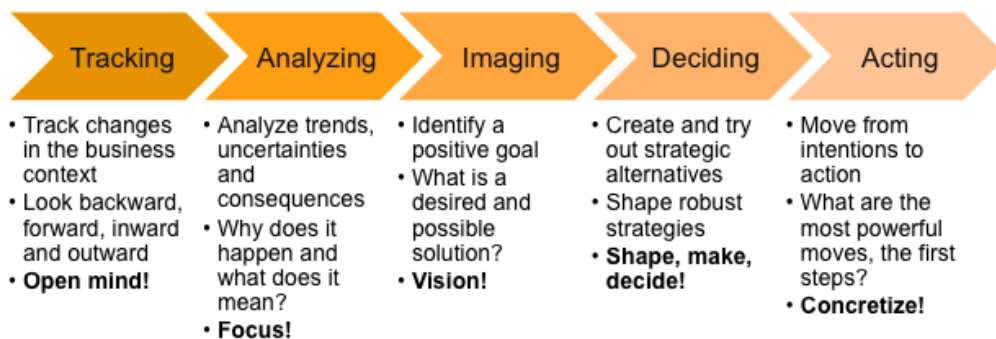

The ICFS is targeted at companies and organisations wishing to **build the necessary in-house expertise for developing futures perspectives and strategy.** It is a **tailored executive education programme** with an emphasis on learning in an international environment. The course is best suited to those individuals in management positions, who have or will have a responsibility to shape and enhance strategic thinking within their company.

THE SUBSTANTIVE CONTENT OF THE ICFS

The course will follow a proven analytical framework called TAIDA (Tracking, Analyzing, Imaging, Deciding and Acting. TAIDA is a trademark of Kairos Future). It enables participants to understand step-by-step the theory and practice of futures thinking and strategy development. Individual elements will be taught in their own tailored modules, each one building on the skills and concepts learnt before.

The focus of the ICFS programme is on the practical application of these skills:



THE LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF THE ICFS PROGRAMME

Individuals attending the course will be **equipped with the skills and knowledge needed to address the changes facing their organisation.**
