
In order to successfully cope, companies need to understand their current business environment, and visualise future developments. Organisations need to anticipate and understand change and they need to proactively plan for it, so as to increase their resilience and secure their future competitive advantage.

The “International Certified Future Strategist” (ICFS) programme helps organisations do just that. The development of the ICFS course and the job category of Certified Future Strategist has been funded with the support of the European Commission’s ‘Leonardo da Vinci Programme for life-long learning’.

THE MODEL OF THE ICFS

The course follows a proven analytical framework called TAIDA, short for Tracking, Analysing, Imagining, Deciding and Acting*. It enables participants to understand step-by-step the theory and practice of futures thinking and strategy development. Each element is taught in their own tailored modules, building on the skills and concepts learnt in previous modules.

The focus of the ICFS programme is on the practical application of the TAIDA model and how to implement future studies and strategy development in the participants own organisations.

ABOUT THE COURSE

WHO SHOULD SIGN UP?

The ICFS is targeted at companies and organisations wishing to build the necessary in-house expertise for developing futures perspectives and strategy, and at individuals who want to enhance and impact their career path by learning and developing these skills.

The course is a tailored executive education programme with an emphasis on learning in an international environment. The course is best suited to individuals in management positions, who have a responsibility to shape and enhance strategic thinking within their company.

An ideal candidate for the ICFS has:

- A few years of work experience or/and academic training
- A good command of the English language
- A managerial position in his/her organisation

THE LEARNING OBJECTIVES OF THE ICFS PROGRAMME

Individuals attending the course will learn the skills and knowledge needed to address the challenges facing their organisation, including: how to assess change, how to create scenarios, how to develop strategy, and how to implement and communicate change.

The course is robust, in terms of both theory and application, but is also intensely practical, focusing on the real-world needs of business, organisations and individuals.

The ICFS course offers three main advantages compared to other courses available on the market: ICFS goes deeper in the scenario analysis than competitors; clearly emphasizes the link between scenarios and strategy, and provides the possibility to get certified after the course.

THE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

We strongly believe in “learning by doing”. We mix theory with practice, with participants able to test different methods, techniques, while at the course. Participants benefit from a hands-on environment, with a large amount of interaction between participants and our experienced course tutors. The course provides a relaxed but professional environment which supports the sharing of perspectives, ideas and learning.

The course is composed of four modules (see page 6). In-between modules, participants carry out home assignments, where they can practice their learning in their own organisations.

At the end of the course, participants who have completed the required assignments and presentations are able to get a formal certification which confirms their ability to proficiently use the techniques taught on the course.

THE CONTENT OF THE ICFS MODULES


The ICFS programme duration is approximately five months, with four modules of three days face-to-face teaching each. The course will be held one time a year and admits about 20 participants. The schedule for 2017 is the following:

Module 1: Environmental analysis (25-27 January 2017)

Module 2: Scenarios (8-10 March 2017)

Module 3: Vision & strategy analysis (5-7 April 2017)

Module 4: Strategy & action (10-12 May 2017)

FEES

The programme fee for the ICFS course is €7,000 (all prices are excluding VAT). This is inclusive of lunches and course materials, but exclusive of travel and related costs.

CERTIFICATION

Many participants on the ICFS course want their achievement recognised through our unique certification and qualification options. This will enable participants to demonstrate to employers, clients, or educational bodies what they have learned and achieved on the course.

We have two different ways you can demonstrate your achievement after completing the ICFS course:

Certification is optional and will take place after the fourth module. Our Certification Scheme has been designed and is audited by an independent body (ExMi of Sweden) and demonstrates to employers and clients that you have acquired the skills and competencies to lead futures orientated strategy projects including factor and trends analysis, scenario development, and strategy options development. Under the scheme, the course tutors assess each participant at the end of the programme against the Certification criteria. Those who meet the criteria will be able to describe themselves as “International Certified Future Strategists”.

Certification is only available for those who complete the ICFS course and is included in the course price and is valid for three years.

The ICFS course has also been accredited by the UK’s Chartered Management Institute as meeting the learning objectives of their Award in Professional Consulting. This academic qualification is recognised by educational bodies across Europe under the EQF (European Qualification Framework) and can be transferred as points towards a larger qualification. To obtain the Award participants must submit project work which is independently assessed by examiners from the Chartered Management Institute. The cost of this assessment is not covered by the course fee and is €150.

CANCELLATION POLICY
